



Repair Kit instructions for La Bassine birth pool.

Our pools are made to a very high standard using heavy duty, high quality material. Although the chances of puncturing the pool are minimal, accidents can happen. In the event of an air leak, please read all the instructions carefully before attempting a repair.

1. Please carry out your repair in a well ventilated area. Keep well away from flames, fire and cigarettes.
2. Make sure the part to be repaired is clean and dry.
3. Take one repair patch and place over damaged area and draw around edge lightly with a pencil.
4. Remove patch and apply a thin even coat of glue to BOTH the area you traced and the patch. Leave to dry for around 10 minutes depending on temperature of room etc..
5. Apply a second coat, leave for 1-3 minutes until tacky, but do **NOT** allow to dry.
6. Carefully apply patch onto repair area making sure there are no creases on the patch.
7. Using a small wall paper roller or similar, press out any trapped air bubbles.
8. Leave for at least 24 hours before using or inflating, or rolling to pack away.

Your pool must be fully deflated before repair
